You have in your hands a game that requires a good sense of humour, honesty and understanding. Are you ready to admit the most embarrassing moments of your life that you have never spoken about?

Warning!

The game is not suitable for children under 18 as it contains many questions about adult life only.

PURPOSE OF THE GAME

Oh My God! is a fun game in which players admit to embarrassing moments in their lives. By the end of the game, we will know our fellow players a bit better, and they will learn something peculiar and unbelievable about us that they didn't know before.

THE CARDS

The deck consists of 100 question cards, each with one question. The questions can be funny, embarrassing or bold. You'll find that you have to admit to some and deny others. There are also 4 blank

cards on which you can write your own questions. The set also includes 8 answer cards.

PREPARATIONS

You will need at least three players. Before you start playing, decide whether you will play with your cards revealed or hidden.

HOW TO PLAY

The shuffled deck is placed in the middle, face down. Players decide who will begin the game. There are three ways to continue.

down, in front of them, with the correct answer toward the asker. The asker then collects all the answer cards, shuffles them and says how many of the players have done or not done what was written on the question card. This will show how similar or different the players

are. The players are then returned their answer cards and the player who is next clockwise asks the next question. The game goes on until all cards have been read out.

PLAYING WITH CARDS REVEALED

This version is recommended for a bolder circle of players, as it will reveal more exciting information about each other. It is harder to hide secrets when playing with the cards revealed. The first player takes the top card from the deck and reads out the question on it. The players may previously agree on whether the question will be

answered by the asker or by all the players. Answers may be given using the answer cards or orally. If only the asker answers, the answer is oral. After answering, the next player clockwise asks the next question. The game goes on until all cards have been read out.

ADDITIONAL VERSION

A great choice if you want to find out how well the people in the group know each other. In this version of the game, players do not answer the questions about themselves, but try to guess the answers of their fellow players.

The first player takes the top card from the deck and asks the question on the card. The other players guess if the asker would answer yes or no, and place the answer card face down in front of the asker, placing the correct answer toward the asker. When everyone has answered, the asker reads the answers and reveals the truth. Players are allowed and advised to ask additional details about the event, e.g. when, with whom, etc.
